Requirements for Utility Vehicles

1. Required Safety Equipment

All utility and courtesy service vehicles to be used on campus must be equipped with:

- a. Headlamps
- b. Multi-beam lamps (exempt if used only during light hours). Courtesy service vehicles must have headlights but are not required to have multi-beam lamps.
- c. Tail lamps
- d. Stop lamps
- e. Turn signals
- f. Reflectors
- g. Brakes
- h. Parking Brake
- i. Mirrors
- j. Muffler (exempt if vehicle is electric powered)
- k. Horn
- l. Windshield wipers (exempt if not equipped with a windshield)
- m. Slow moving vehicle emblem on back
- n. Amber strobe light on roof (exempt if not equipped with a roof)
- o. Seatbelts
- p. Roll bar or similar structural system or device
- q. Vehicles that are able to be registered titled and plated are preferred.
