The focus of the Symposium will be to examine the state and the future of the field of high-energy Astroparticle Physics. ABSTRACT SUBMISSION:

The Symposium will consist of invited presentations and contributed talks. Contributed talks will be selected based on abstract submission and evaluation by members of the International Advisory Board. Abstracts should be submitted electronically at the meeting website. Please use the templates provided and create a PDF file ready to upload. Follow the upload link on the website, and use the username: IAPS08 and password: physics08 to log in to the secure upload area. The deadline for abstract submission is February 29th, 2008.
