

If You Experience Sexual Violence, Sexual Harassment, Stalking, Domestic Violence or Dating Violence

Mines is concerned about the safety and well-being of its community members. Its policies prohibit sexual harassment and sexual violence, including stalking, domestic violence, and dating violence.

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 and Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibit discrimination based on sex, including sexual harassment and sexual violence. The Violence against Women Act amendments to the Clery Act require institutions to develop policies prohibiting sexual assault, stalking, and domestic violence. Mines investigations may result in discipline of an offender and remedial measures for victims, including work accommodations and no-contact orders. Mines internal investigation processes are handled as discreetly as possible, but confidentiality cannot be guaranteed. Mines prohibits retaliation for raising complaints of sexual misconduct, stalking, or dating or domestic violence.
